You will support the teachers in your department to establish and maintain a positive, focused classroom where student learning, innovation and involvement is actively encouraged.

- establish and maintain a positive focused classroom where student learning, innovation and involvement is actively encouraged, and where the class is united as an important element contributing to the Christian atmosphere and ongoing programs at Holy Trinity Lutheran College
- encourage and support teachers in the development of personal professional learning plans within the department
- meet with the Head of Sub-school and College Principal as requested to discuss and monitor aspects of student progress within the department.

- Demonstrate an excellent knowledge of the relevant VCE subjects.
- Ability to plan effective documented VCE study designs that include weekly plans and long term overviews.
- Ability to keep current records on students using a range of assessment data.
- Ability to innovate in your daily program.

### ***SC3: Demonstrated skills which reflect commitment to and understanding of the Christian ethos of the college.***

- Ability to maintain a positive, focused, well-managed classroom with a high standard of pastoral care.
- Ability to include parents as partners in a child's learning journey.
- Ability to support students in a Christian setting.
- Willingness to contribute to the maintenance of the Christian-based, caring atmosphere of the college.
